


## How to Complete the Laws of The Game

Please note that every participant must have their own individual log in.

To complete the laws of the game you will need a learner account on the Football Australia Learning Centre.

### **Follow these steps:**

- Go to [2026 Season Referee \(New\)](#) and register as Match Official. Please use your previous PlayFootball Account and details.
- Follow the account set up prompts / instructions to create your learner account. There is a \$5 Football Australia Levy for this registration.
- At Step 3 Please follow the below instructions carefully. If a Working With Children's Check is not uploaded, or an exemption is not submitted we are unable to approve registration.



- For participants who are UNDER the age of 18 – ***respond NO to the request for WWCC then scroll down to enter the following:***

***Then update WWCC Exemption with the following:***

***State: South Australia,***

***Type: Other***

***Reason: Under 18 (Child's DOB)***


- For participants who are **18 and over** you will need to upload a volunteer WWCC. [Apply for a check](#)

**Please note: If you are 14 or older you will need a valid Working With Children Check before you can begin refereeing (but not to complete the courses). Please make sure you supply us with a copy as soon as you receive it.**

- Wait for the registration approval. This will automatically create a [Football Australia Learning Centre](#) Account for you. If this has not occurred within 5 days of your approval, please reach out on our contact details below.

- Complete the [FREE Laws of the game course.](#)

Log in, select training library, select Laws of the Game- complete the content.



Once you have completed the **Laws of The Game** course you can move onto the **Junior Football Match Official (JFMO)** or **Senior Football Match Official (SFMO)** course.
