

How to Register for a Football Australia Learning Centre Account


Please note that every participant must have their own individual log in.

To complete any Match Official courses, including Laws of the Game, you will need a learner account on the Football Australia Learning Centre.

If you have previously obtained any referee or coaching credentials you will already have an account. If you are unsure if you have an account already, please contact us on the details below and we can confirm this for you.

To Create a New Account:

1. Go to [Learner SA Referee 2026](#) and register as Match Official. Please use your previous PlayFootball Account and details.
2. Follow the account set up prompts / instructions to create your learner account. If prompted to search for a club enter “Learner SA” and select the one at the Parkside location.
3. At Step 3, please follow the below instructions carefully. **If a Working With Children’s Check is not uploaded, or an exemption is not submitted we are unable to approve registration.**

Please note: If you are 13 you will need a valid Working With Children Check when you turn 14 to continue refereeing. You can apply for a Check approximately one month before your birthdate. Please make sure you supply us with a copy as soon as you receive it.

4. Once your registration has been approved it will trigger the creation of a [Football Australia Learning Centre](#) Account for you. If this has not occurred within 5 days of your approval, please reach out on our contact details below.
