FACT SHEET

Tier 1 – Entry-Level Participation

Introducing new participants to football through:

- School programs
- Community participation initiatives

Outcome: Participants experience football for the first time and develop a passion for the game.

Tier 2 – Community Football Hubs

Providing ongoing football opportunities for participants who face logistical and financial barriers to joining organised football.

Community Hubs:

- Deliver weekly football sessions through modified games in local communities
- Remove financial barriers through the ORSR Sports Voucher
- Create safe, inclusive and culturally welcoming environments
- Keep young people engaged in football while building confidence, friendships and life skills

Outcome: Participants remain connected to football instead of leaving the game.

Tier 3 – Football SA Variety Football Foundation Fund

Supporting participants to transition into club football through financial assistance.

The Variety Football Foundation Fund helps eligible participants with costs such as:

- Club registration fees

Outcome: More young people successfully transition into long-term community club football.
